Call to Order

Note

- The County Administrator notified the commissioners and the public that Commissioner Burten would be present for the meeting via telephone, and would place his vote on the matter verbally in order for the commissioners and public to be able to hear his vote.

Business


- Resolution to Approve 2019 Ad Valorem Millage Rates
 - The County Administrator explained that each year the County must adopt a resolution to levy ad valorem taxes per State Law. He then went on to reading out the millage rates for each entity. The millage rates are as follows:
 - Washington County Board of Commissioners – 9.647
 - Washington Board of Education – 16.986
 - Washington County Development Authority – 0.500
 - Washington County Board of Commissioners – Hospital – 3.000
 - The County Administrator explained that the millage rates for the Board of Commissioners and the Development Authority remained identical to 2018, while the Board of Education reduced its rate slight from 17.048 to 16.986. He then asked the commissioners if there were any questions or concerns, and if there were none to formally vote on the resolution.
 - Chairman Daniel asked for a motion to approve the resolution. A motion was made by Commissioner Watkins to approve the resolution, seconded by Commissioner Hitchcock. The motion was passed unanimously.
