
Commissioners Present: Horace Daniel, Doug Watkins, Edward Burten, James Hitchcock, Frank Simmons

Call to Order

Business

- Executive Session – Personnel
 - Chairman Daniel asked for a motion to enter into Executive Session.
 - A motion was made by Commissioner Simmons, seconded by Commissioner Watkins. The motion was passed unanimously.
 - Commissioner Burten attended the called meeting following the end of the Executive Session and was present for the remainder of the called meeting.
 - Chairman Daniel stated that we should go ahead and vote on the issue. Commissioner Hitchcock agreed that a vote should be taken instead of waiting, citing inaction as the reason the 911 Center is in the shape it is in now.
 - Chairman Daniel stated that with the information heard from the consultant and the recommendation made to improve the 911 Center, it is recommended to allow the Sheriff to be in charge of the 911 Center.
 - Chairman Daniel asked for motion to allow the Sheriff to be in charge of the 911 Center, with an agreement to be written that addresses the concerns voiced in the Executive Session.
 - A motion was made by Commissioner Watkins, seconded by Commissioner Simmons. The motion was passed 4-0, with Commissioner Burten abstaining.
